












### HURRICANE IAN IMPACTS

- Damage sustained at 90% of the 447 Countywide signals
- 103 County/City intersections damaged over \$5,000
- 42 signal cabinets with saltwater intrusion
- Contract to the BOCC 9/19
- Total damage to the signal system in the \$8M range
- Damage at 11 county owned bridges
- Legislative appropriations requested and received for much of the County share









### INNOVATIVE TRANSPORTATION

- Interconnected traffic signal system
  - Fiberoptic Communication to 98% of the County signals
  - Ability to diagnose signal issues from the TOC
- Real time camera feeds to the media and TOC
  - 150+ pan, tilt, zoom cameras
- BlueTooth travel time readers
- Emergency Preemption
  - South Trail & Iona/McGregor Fire Districts
  - Future Expansion???
